Jason, what is your earliest memory?

Jason:

This is the information my adoptive mother gave to me. My birth name was John Stout. I was born in 1964 in Indianapolis, Indiana at an unwed mother's hospital. When I was born, they had trouble in the delivery room. They had to use forceps. The results of this can still be seen and felt. I was also born with fetal alcohol syndrome. From birth it was known that mental state could be that of either a vegetable, be highly intelligent or have Down syndrome. Because of my medical issues, I was passed between three different families before I got a Social Security number.

In 1957, Jerry Stephens got out of the Korean conflict. He was from Carroll. He liked to drink beer at the Polish Club. He met Melanie Franklin at the Club. Melanie came from South Dakota by way of Cincinnati. Jerry and Melanie got married. Jerry liked to go up to the lakes in northeast Indiana. He bought a trailer on Manterra Lake. In 1964, the Stephens family adopted me. Jerry and Melanie changed my name to "Jason".

All my life my mother and great grandmother (Ada Clippy) told me that I was chosen. I believe that. At age 4, Ada gave me coffee and toast. Ada rented a trailer from us. She kept a glass of beer on the table. I used to sneak into her trailer. I drank beer out of her glass. One day, she put vinegar in the beer to try and teach me a lesson. That was the last time I drank HER beer.

My dad was my hero. I followed him around like a pup. He could fix anything. He worked as a tool and die expert for General Motors. He invented the Sonic Weld for the taillights at Guide Lamp in Anderson, Indiana. I wanted to be like him. During the winter months, he drove a tractor and pulled me on a sled. It was a lot of fun. They adopted my sister in 1967. I was her protector. She had red hair. Kids picked on her at school. When I was 4 years old my mom and dad wouldn't take me out in public. I was young. I wanted all the attention, especially when they adopted my sister. I started stealing and lying. I got my way all the time. In total, the cult adopted six kids and put us in homes in Sycamore Forest. There was me and another boy and two girls less than 10 years old. There were two other boys in their mid-teens.

At age 5, I went to Harrison Elementary School. My dad worked the night shift. He dropped me off for afternoon kindergarten. I walked in, but no one was there. Being five, I panicked. I walked out and started hitchhiking down 53rd St. in Carroll. A mailman picked me up and took me home. That incident led to
